

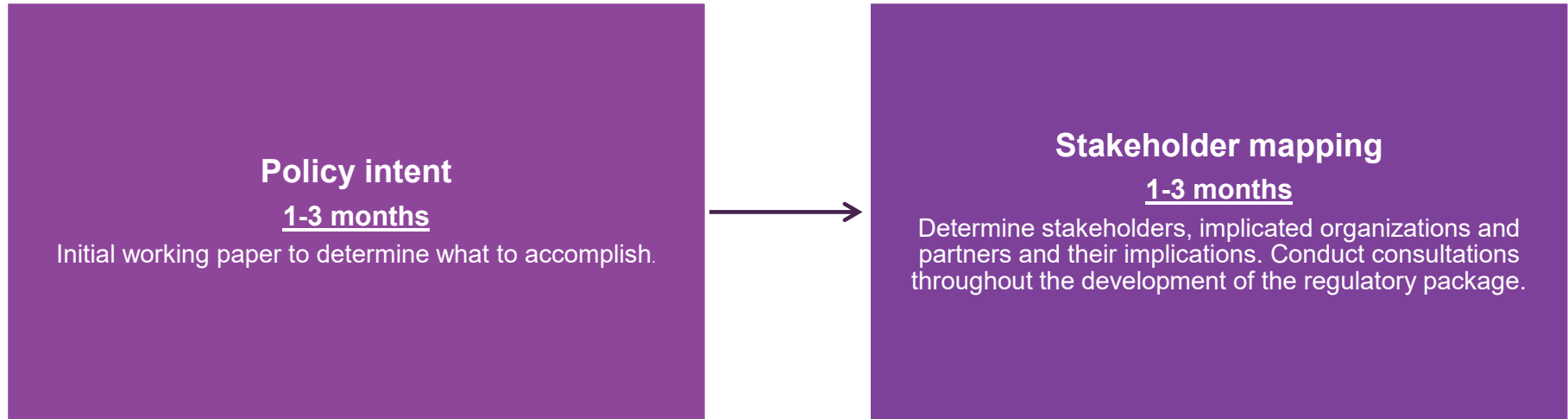

Legal Issues Management Committee (LIMC) 2-4 months

When the triage statement form is approved by the TBS analyst, finalize the LIMC documentation in order to get on LIMC's agenda. Drafting instructions must be completed with legal counsel and included in LIMC package.



Drafting regulations 4-6 months

The draft regulations process will begin with DoJ drafters. The draft regs will be based on the DI's. Revisors and jurilinguists will review the draft regs in order to obtain the blue stamps.

Regulatory Impact Analysis Statement (RIAS)

4-6 months

A draft RIAS will need to be completed for LIMC. A final approved RIAS will need to be completed in order to move forward. CBA, AMTI and GBA plus analyses are done separately.



Regulatory Package

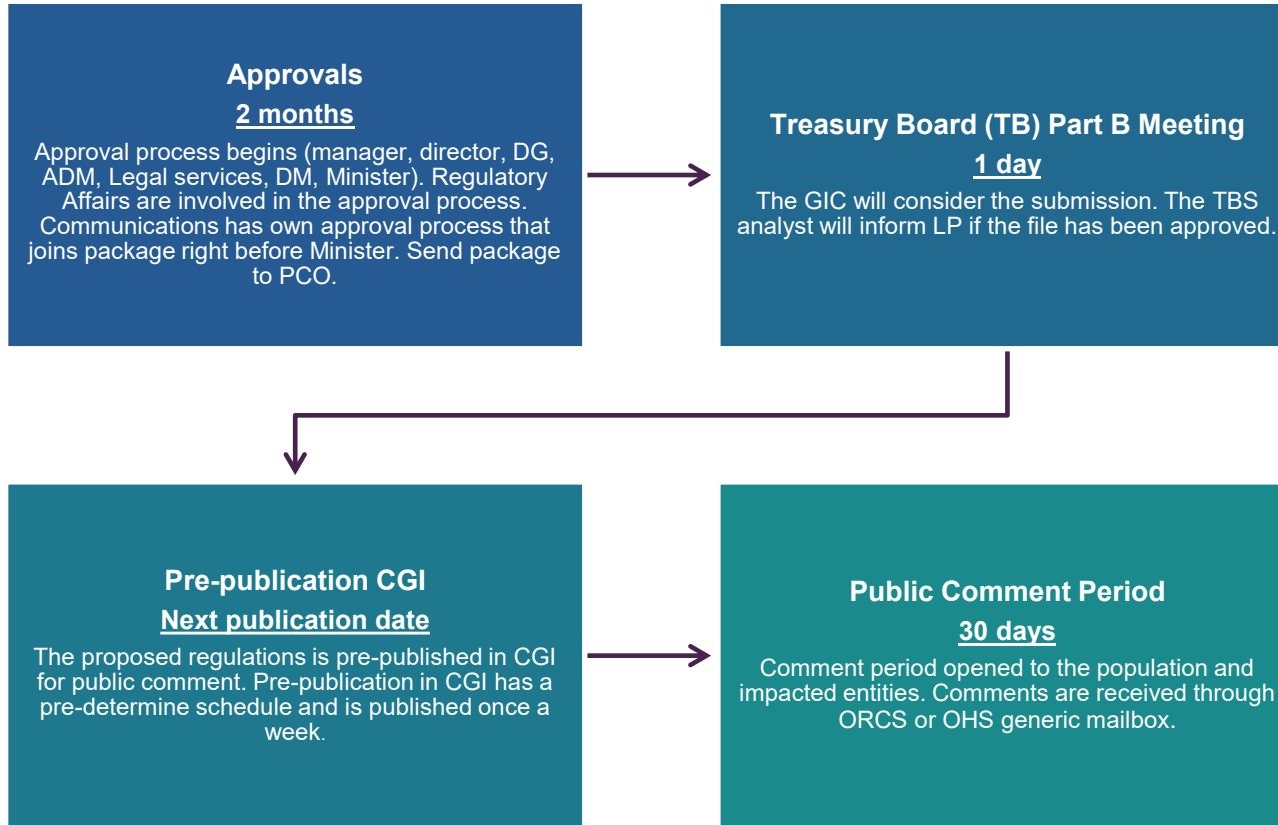
1 month

LP develops and prepares the regulatory package and share it with the impacted departments.
Obtain manager's and director's approval.

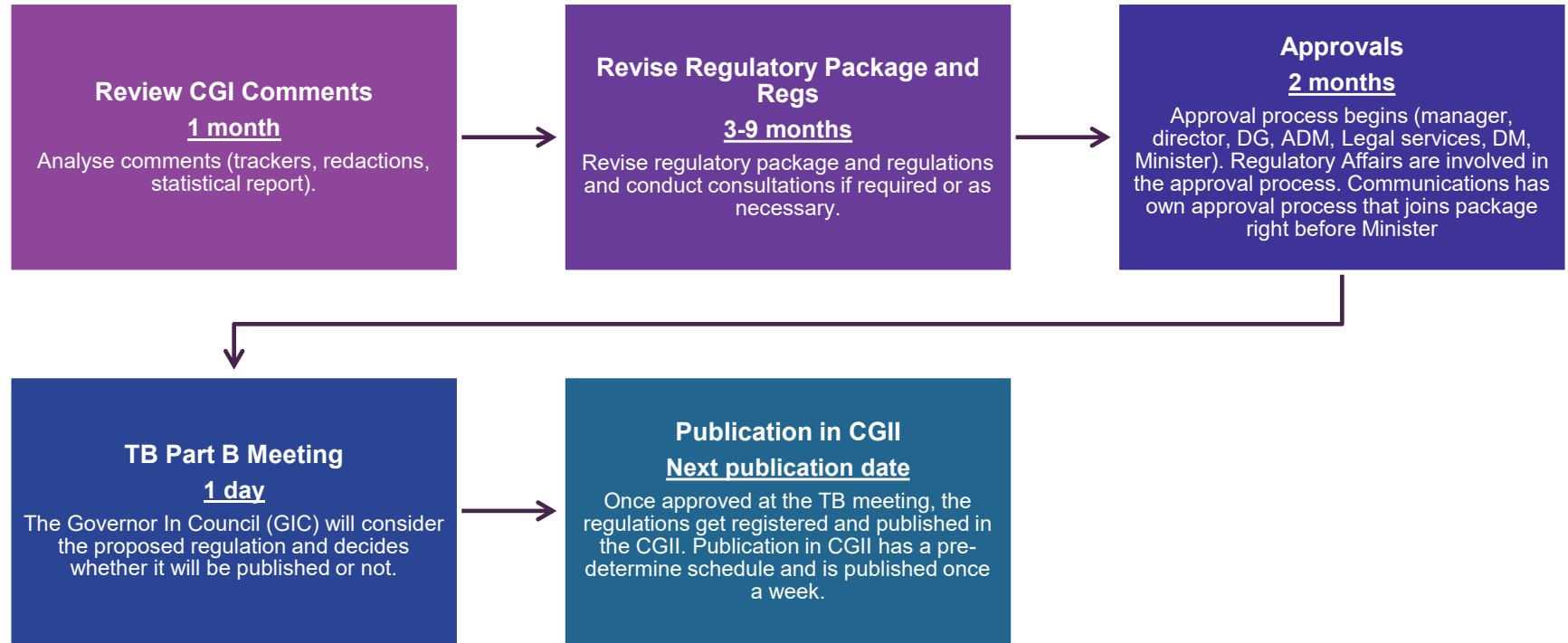

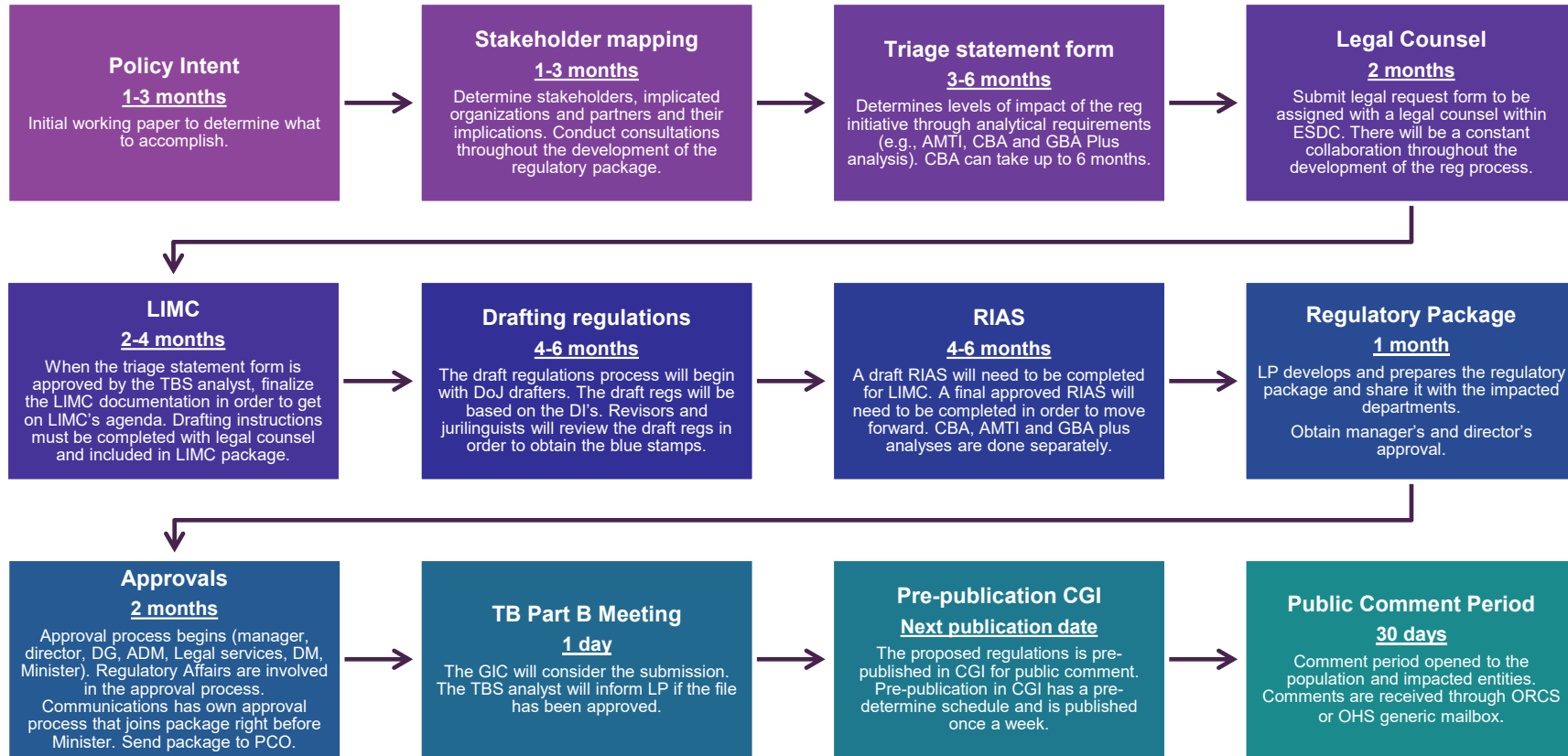
